Chilton Village Hall Improvements Progress Update

Following the successful consultation that was finalised earlier this year, we are pleased to announce that planning consent has been granted for the proposed extension and upgrade of the existing hall. Currently we are working together with the Architects on finalising the details of the design. We hope to go to tender soon, to assign a building contractor, and the aim is to start the work on site this autumn.

At present we are taking bookings, up to and including the 13th October, and we can guarantee that the Hall will be available until this date. We then expect the Hall to be closed for up to 6 months, so cannot accept casual bookings during that period.

We are working with our regular hirers to find alternative venues for them all to ensure minimal disruption.

Construction has started on the new Community Room (CR), and it is due for completion in September, however we anticipate that the CR will not be licensed and equipped until early 2014.

We are currently looking actively for additional Village Hall Committee Members to help us run both this great new facility and the improved and extended Hall and can't do it without new blood.
